INTRODUCTION

Geita Rural Children Support Organisation (GRUCSO) is a non-governmental organisation (registration No. 22NGO/R/3661) that was established to provide support to less privileged children and youth in rural areas of Geita Region. The organisation enrolls and retains the students through providing guidance, counselling, and material support (such as paying for their school fees, hostel, stationery, uniforms, books and other related needs for their education). GRUCSO is an advocate to combat gender and domestic violence, promote children's rights, and assist youth and adolescents through vocational and technical training.

During November – December 2025, the organisation is proud and grateful to have made a difference in the lives of disadvantaged children through the following interventions.

OUR FIRST FORM FOUR GRADUATES (ORDINARY SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION)

His Form 4 examination results are commendable. He achieved **Division 2 with C grades** in all subjects, including Mathematics, Physics, Biology and Chemistry. EDUCATION MATERIAL SUPPORT

Following a needs assessment, our beneficiaries were provided with education and school supplies to support their education and career. The materials included textbooks (Physics, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, History, English, Kiswahili and Geography), stationery, uniforms, school bags, a pair of school shoes, exercise books, counter books, home clothes and shoes, four figures, graph paper and mathematical sets. These items were provided to 14 children from the Geita Municipal District and the Geita District.
